In 2021, \$32,380 was sent to Haiti from parishioner donations and the Foundation grant to pay **basic expenses**. We pay the yearly salary for 33 awesome women and men. They teach, administer, cook for, and provide security for our nearly 500 students. Even though it is unsafe to travel to Haiti currently, school goes on! Talented architect Bob Carlson has provided plans for this hurricane/earthquake resistant structure. Haitian laborers will be paid to build it under the supervision of our outstanding new priest, Father Fred Menelas.

ANTICIPATED EXPENSES

One can never really anticipate expenses for the next year when earthquakes and hurricanes seem to be the new normal in Haiti. However, we know our 30 staff and nearly 500 children are dependent on our continued support. They are grateful for our parish every day. They include us in their prayers of the people every Sunday. In 2021 we (the parish) sent \$76,184 to support the school and help the community with earthquake relief. Hopefully, 2022 will be disaster free and back to basic expenses and general repairs/upkeep.
