SACRED GROUND

A film and readings-based dialogue series on race, grounded in faith, hope love and history. Small groups walk through chapters of America's history of racism, while weaving in threads of family, economic class, politics and regional identity. The 11-part series is built around an online curriculum of documentary films and readings focused on Indigenous, Black, Latino/Hispanic, and Asian/Pacific American histories as they intersected with European American histories. The series is open to all and designed to help White people talk with other White people, peeling away layers that contributed to the challenges and divides of the present day.
